- **Optional WEEK #3 – *Teen Leadership Camp*** at Hidden Valley Camp in Maine. This program combines sustainable agriculture and an environmental focus with community service. Teens can stay on longer in the Teen Leadership Camp. Please contact [Jane@ocdf.org](mailto:Jane@ocdf.org) if your teen desires to do so or if you would like more program details.

### **Pick a Combination of Weeks? Join as a Family?**

- Teens can join OCDF's new program for Week #1 only, Week #2 only, Week #3 only, or Weeks 1 + 2, or Weeks 2 + 3 or all three! Weeks 1 + 2 + 3!
- Can parents and siblings join in? Parents and siblings (those under age 12) and even your relatives are welcome to join Week #1 only. Weeks #2 and #3 are for TEENS ONLY (teens and siblings ages 12-16 are welcome).
- What if I'm adopted from China but I'm older than 16 – like 17 or 18? Yes, you can also join the program as a *peer counselor*! Contact [Jane@ocdf.org](mailto:Jane@ocdf.org) for more information.
- Can parents visit their teens at camp in Maine? Yes, we will arrange for a parent visit time for each group. However, parents may not take their teens off-site from the camp nor disrupt the normal schedule of Hidden Valley Camp or this program. Information on visiting camp will be included on our website [www.ocdf.org/camps](http://www.ocdf.org/camps) along with options for where to stay near the camp. Visits will be limited to one meal and half-day.

### **What are the costs involved and what is included?**

This program is “all inclusive”- the only additional cost will be getting from home to the start point of the program and getting back home from the program. You can either drive your teen to the start point and pick up at the ending point or you can have them fly as an unaccompanied minor whereby the airline will monitor them and we will sign for your child when they arrive/ depart.

**Included** in the per person price: program staff/escorts/camp counselors and licensed tour guides including gratuity (for the Week #1 program), daily transportation by motor coach/bus including driver gratuity, hotel (Week 1)/cabin (Week 2)/house (Week 3), 3 meals per day and some special meal functions, entrance fees, special reserve tickets, performances, activities listed on itinerary, t-shirt, bag, workbook keyed to the activities, money holder, and luggage tags. Participants in the 2-week or optional Teen Leadership program will have laundry costs included. Participants in one-week programs will not have laundry included. Participants should have their own medical insurance or travel medical insurance if coming from outside the US.

**Not included:** Snack foods and beverages, gifts purchased during the sightseeing program, or other personal costs such as phone calls home, internet use at hotel (should it not be included in the room).

**Program rules include but are not limited to:** Cell phone and computer use will be limited to free time at hotel (evening) and at special camp locations designated for phone or email use. The entire program and camp are non-smoking and free of electronic games, please respect this requirement. Use of alcohol, tobacco of any kind, and any drugs other than prescriptions authorized by a physician will be cause for immediate dismissal from the program at the parent's expense.

Special dietary restrictions and food allergies should be identified on the registration form. Nursing staff is on-site at Hidden Valley Camp. Counselors and OCDF staff are Red Cross CPR and first aid trained/certified.

### **Who will meet my teen in Washington DC/NYC/Portland ME?**

When you send your teen as an “unaccompanied minor” on a flight to one of the three starting locations, an OCDF staff member will meet your teen and have to sign for them from the airline. The airline would be told by you (at time of check-in) the name of the person(s) meeting your teen’s flight (which we would provide you in advance). We will sign for your teen and accompany them to join the group. While teens 14 years of age and older may fly without the “unaccompanied minor” designation (without assistance), we will insist that all participants arriving by air be so designated so that if a flight were to be delayed or cancelled, there would be someone with the teen to assist them in rerouting their flight and being in contact with you and with OCDF.

### **Who will travel with the teens and monitor them?**

OCDF Staff are well-trained to work with families and their children including teens. All of our staff are Red Cross CPR and First Aid Certified and undergo background checks to assure their suitability to work with your teens. Director of Teen Programs in China is Wesley Smith and in the USA is Merritt Wilson (who has worked for OCDF in the Beijing Office in the past). Merritt Wilson will coordinate each group during the Week 1 portion of the program in conjunction with a travel escort and licensed tour guides from each sightseeing location. The coordinator for Week #2 will be Tony Zheng who has worked for OCDF in the Beijing Office for 5 years and has been on assignment in the US in the past. Camp Counselor who will assist Tony in Maine is Molly Rau (big sister to two girls adopted from China). And, the camp staff of Hidden Valley Camp are amazing – we have already checked them out in 2009.

## How do I sign up my teen and/or family for this program?

- Download from [www.ocdf.org/camps](http://www.ocdf.org/camps) the American Adventure Camp full-color brochure which includes (in English and in Chinese) the general information for camp and registration/ medical forms. Print one registration form for each teen participating in the program.
- For those not living in China, please also complete (in addition to the main application) the general reservation form included **with this packet** to indicate which options your teen or family will be joining.
- Submit application form and reservation form to OCDF with a non-refundable \$200.00 USD deposit per person. Please check with [Jane@ocdf.org](mailto:Jane@ocdf.org) or online at [www.ocdf.org/camps](http://www.ocdf.org/camps) as to the status of each group (whether space is still available, how much space is available, or if that session is already full). It is our desire to fill the programs from Group 1 thru Group 8. However, we will try to honor any requests to place a teen or family in a specific group or program dates.
- Deadline for application including medical information and non-refundable deposit is February 1, 2010
- Deadline for balance of program payment is March 1, 2010
- No funds will be refunded after April 1, 2010. Should a teen or family need to defer to 2011 due to medical reasons or death in the family, we will be willing to work with you to do so. However, depending on the date of cancellation, we may not be able to defer all payments made to our contractors for reservations (especially tickets for events and air tickets).
